

Cat: Heartworm, Flea, Intestinal and other External Parasite Prevention Options

Drug Name	Application Instructions	Prevents against Heartworm	Treats Fleas (mode of action against fleas)	Treats Ticks	Treats Intestinal Parasites and/or External Parasites
Revolution	Applied to skin once/month	Prevents against heartworm disease(Kills immature heartworms introduced to the cat in the last 30 days, preventing the development of adult heartworms)	Flea adulticide that treats and controls flea infestations and will continue to protect from further flea infestation for at least 4 weeks (kills adult fleas, eggs, and larvae)	DOES NOT	Treats and controls intestinal roundworm and hookworm infections Treats and controls ear mite infestations
Advantage	Applied to skin once/month	DOES NOT	Flea adulticide that treats and controls flea infestations on cats within 1 day of treatment and will continue to protect from further flea infestation for at least 4 weeks	DOES NOT	DOES NOT
Interceptor	Flavour tab tablet given orally once/month	Prevention of heartworm disease	DOES NOT	DOES NOT	Treats and controls parasitic infections due to adult hookworm and adult roundworm
Capstar	Tablet given orally daily as needed for the elimination of adult fleas	DOES NOT	Flea adulticide that eliminates adult fleas when they bite a treated animal; works within 20 minutes	DOES NOT	DOES NOT
